Slurry Splash Guard

When producing cellular concrete, one of the messiest parts is the discharge of slurry from ready mix trucks into the hoppers of pump equipment. In most cases the "base slurry" has a consistency of thick chocolate milk, so when being discharged off a truck at a rate of 50-150 gallons per minute, it splashes all over equipment and personnel. Some equipment owners will build large hopper extensions to help contain the mess, but these can get bulky and obstruct the view of operators. Richway offers a simple splash guard solution. As can be seen, it's simply a heavy-duty rubber splash guard that attaches to the chute of the ready mix truck once when it arrives at the jobsite. The splash shield uses a simple, heavy duty latch to ensure it stays fastened to the chute, and won't get destroyed by the harsh environment. A key to the effectiveness is the thickness and weight of the rubber. It's heavy enough to not be simply pushed out of the way of the slurry flow, and yet flexible enough to dampen the flow and eliminate the splash.
